


Support eligible patients to get a maternity exemption certificate



New and expectant mums need a maternity exemption certificate to get free NHS prescriptions.

The certificate can also be used to prove they are entitled to free NHS dental treatment.



NHS maternity exemption certificates

Patients who are pregnant or have had a baby in the last 12 months need a maternity exemption certificate to claim free NHS prescriptions.

If you are a midwife, you can support eligible patients to apply for the certificate


Complete the application:

- online through the digital maternity exemption service, or
- using the FW8 paper form.

The certificate entitles the patient to claim for free NHS prescriptions. It can also be used to show they are entitled to free NHS dental treatment.

NHS maternity exemption certificate

Patients who are pregnant or have had a baby in the last 12 months can claim free NHS prescriptions if they have a maternity exemption certificate.

You can help your patients to apply for the certificate by completing the application:

- online through the digital maternity exemption service, or
- using the FW8 paper form.

The maternity exemption certificate entitles the patient to claim free NHS prescriptions. It can also be used to show they are entitled to free NHS dental treatment.

If you're a midwife, practice nurse or health visitor, you can register online to issue digital maternity exemption certificates, meaning your patients will receive their digital certificate straight away by email.
